What appears as you go to the link for this map is just an overview
pop up that describes the map and how

you can use click on each of the points and how you can filter the
data to view certain parts of it.

So let's go over it, clicked OK, and now we are in the interactive map
and as you can see, first off,

we're just looking at all of Illinois and we're viewing the 17
Illinois welcoming centers and some of the names for these centers
appear,

But you can also click on them if any of them are not appearing
because of space wise they may not appear.

You can click on them to see the information about each center.

So this one is the Sal Family and Community Center,
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00:01:23,720 --> 00:01:32,770
That is in Moline, Illinois, and has about 17 partners listed.

Some of the other features of the map, some of the basic ones besides
being able to click on the points, is that you can zoom in and out.

So I'm just scrolling with my mouse, zooming in and out.

You can also zoom in and out in the upper left here. As well as zoom
to particular addresses or places in the search bar.

The thing you could do is see that the layers that are on this
interactive map in the upper right.

This is the legend tab we have here and then this kind of pile of
papers all the way over is the list of layers that are on this map.

So there's two sets of data that are actually for welcoming centers.

One is for those prior to twenty twenty one and one is for those after
twenty twenty one,

That now includes thirty one welcoming centers.

And you can see what we've organized for this map is a list of the
resources that welcoming centers could potentially use in their map.

We have also a list of the partners that welcoming centers have listed
that they work with to serve their clients.

And then there's a line showing a connection from each of the
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welcoming centers to their partner and then what are called service
areas,

that these are comprised of the zip codes that each of the welcoming
centers has described it provides services to.

So let's go in and as you can see, there's a lot a lot of the layers
are not view viewed right now.

And as you can see, that they're gray and gray over here on the right.

But as we zoom in, I'm going to zoom in to Cass County Health
Department's Welcoming Center.

As I zoom in, the other layers start to turn on,
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00:03:36,620 --> 00:03:50,720
so what we see here is the Cass County Health Department and there's a
connection to each of its partners.

And as we zoom in a little more. What we see is that the the labels
for these places should turn on so that one can

view the names of each of the partners as well as the names for each
of the,

We have these triangles

Here are the different resources which we've categorized as resources
from a college disability services organization and vocational rehab
center.

You can also click on any of these and a little pop up will show the
name if the label doesn't appear.

So those that's how this is organized, another feature you can do is
is called panning.

So you grab the map and you can pan around to potentially get to one
of the other areas.

Now, I'm showing the Sal family community services area.

So that's another way to navigate around the map again.

One other feature is this, this purple line dotted line, that's the
service area that's listed now.

Right now, we're reviewing all of the welcoming centers as a whole and
zooming out now.

And it can get kind of messy, you can see all this data now appears as
we zoom in because we're looking at the data for all the welcoming
centers.

We're looking at all the zip codes they serve, all their partners and
all those connections.
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00:05:25,770 --> 00:05:31,750
So it's really a neat interlocking web of services that appear here.
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00:05:31,750 --> 00:05:38,470
But oftentimes we just want to see one center and its service area and
the partners that it listed,
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00:05:38,470 --> 00:05:46,510
So I'm going to close this layer list and zoom out a little bit, back
to where we were.
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00:05:46,510 --> 00:05:50,410
And then I'm going to use a feature called Filter,
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00:05:50,410 \longrightarrow 00:05:58,780
actually called Group Filter that allows us to filter the layers based
on one of the welcoming centers.
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00:05:58,780 --> 00:06:08,230
So I'm going to click on this button and the only piece that's needed
to fill out is where it says empty here.
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00:06:08,230 --> 00:06:15,070
These other pieces of information, you can leave the saying this is
just the way that the search and filter is set up.
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00:06:15,070 --> 00:06:21,490
So I'm going to click on here and filter to this Cass County welcoming
center.
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00:06:21,490 --> 00:06:33,960
So I click on that and then I click on apply, and what you could see
happens is the map zooms in to that welcoming center.
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00:06:33,960 --> 00:06:39,150
And it's showing the extent of all its partners, so for Cass County,
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00:06:39,150 --> 00:06:47,190
the extent is kind of around its area and the county that it's serving
and you can see these are the different
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00:06:47,190 --> 00:06:56,340
partners that it's connected to and the zip code for this zip code
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service area for this welcoming center.
